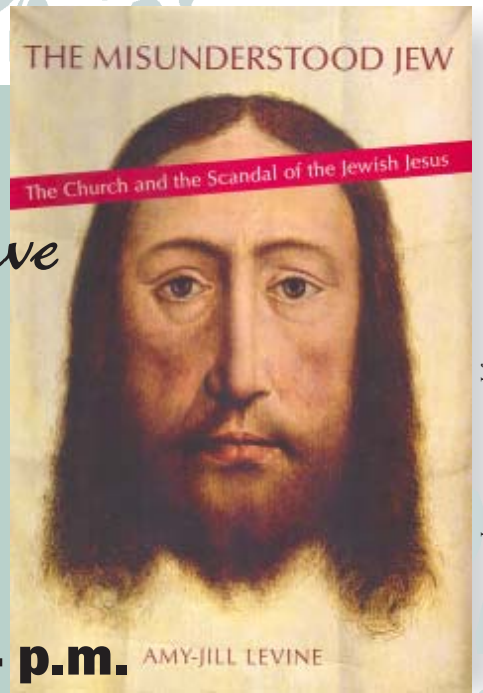


### **Amy-Jill Levine** *A biblical perspective*

### **Karen Lee Turner** *A "wee" worship perspective*

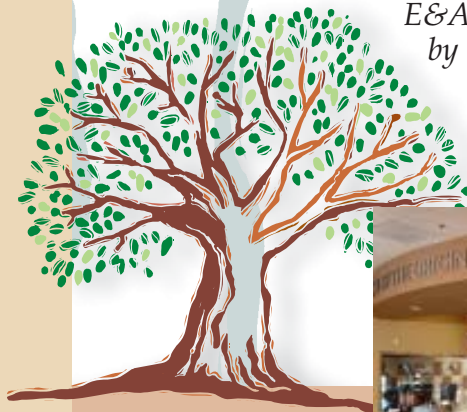
**Jan. 24, 2010 — 4 p.m.**
